- I. Meeting called to Order- Mark Sutton
- II. Conference Cheer- at Bradley- Results handed out- Varsity Champion-Lockport/ Sophomore- Sandburg- by-laws and terms need to be developed for Cheerleading. Co-ed issue needs to be addressed.
- III. SWSC Indoor Track meet- Chris Marzelak gave history of events. General consensus was that 10 teams was too much. It was agreed that it would be 5 team invites for each division. Red division- LWC Varsity level boys and girls- March 25. Blue division- Friday March 24 Girls at Bolingbrook, Friday March 24 at Lockport- Boys. Blue is 2 levels (3 entries), Red is Varsity only.
- IV. Len Motta- Gymnastics assignment chair- Kathy Krebs- need to find out her intentions. She would like to make a presentation on being an assignor. Kathy is to give Len a proposal if she wishes to have it presented. Gymnastics official shortages are a concern.
- V. Conference Wrestling- HF- JV Wrestling. Very long day for JV. 3 mats only. Varsity went well. With four mats 45 minute rest time would be an issue. IHSA and SWSC bylaws need to be in line. IHSA does not necessarily follow the federation. Walkovers are used for IHSA and should be used for SWSC. Rattails and point system should be worked out. Overall the meet for Varsity would be great. The thought is that 10 teams is better than 5.
