



SWSC Athletic Director's Workshop Minutes

September 10, 2008

Bananas Restaurant, Tinley Park, Illinois

Workshop Topic: Utilization of Technology in Athletic Administration

Attendance: Andrew, Bolingbrook, Bradley-Bourbonnais, Homewood-Flossmoor, Joliet Central, Joliet West, Lincoln-Way Central, Lincoln-Way North, Lincoln-Way West, Lockport, Sandburg, Stagg, Thornridge, Thornton, and Thornwood.

- I. The meeting was called to order at 9:00am by President Mr. Ted Robbins
- II. Approval of the Minutes from August 27, 2008: Mr. Randy Konstans motioned to approve the minutes and Mr. Chris Olson seconded. Motion passed.
- III. Assignment Chairperson
 - a. Football: Mr. Ted Robbins contacted Mr. Wayne Layer (Football) and expressed the concern of Zebra Online web information; the on-line official assignments will be available soon. In the interim, official assignments will be faxed to each school. Mr. Wayne Layer confirmed that email correspondence is sufficient to communicate schedule changes. Mr. Rich Piatchek stated that a complete list of officials contact information was not distributed to the athletic directors. Mr. Ted Robbins will have Mr. Wayne Layer send each school a directory of officials.
 - b. Soccer: Mr. Bruce Scheidegger contacted Mrs. Diane Morrow about the need for three officials for Varsity Level contests. Mrs. Diane Morrow stated that the request would be extremely difficult due to the number of available officials. Mr. Randy Konstans and Mr. Alec Anderson received the same response.
- IV. Winter SWSC Mega Meeting: Mr. Ted Robbins reminded the group that the event is scheduled for October 28, 2008 at Sandburg High School. Mr. Bruce Scheidegger is seeking recommendations for guest speakers.
- V. SWSC Athletics 2000 Web Site Report: Mr. Rich Piatchek distributed a report that included missing scores, missing champions, and missing awards. Lincoln-Way North is now listed correctly; the school was listed previously as Lincoln-Way East. Mr. Rich Piatchek needs the contact information for the Sophomore Level Girls' Tennis Coaching Staff.
- VI. IHSA/IADA Update
 - a. IHSA Sportsmanship Initiative: Mr. Ted Robbins distributed the Re-registered Conference Sportsmanship Survey. Each school completed the survey and Mr. Ted Robbins will submit the information to the IHSA. Mr. Rich Piatchek will email the tally sheets for Post-Season Meetings. Mr. Ted Robbins will compile the information from the tally sheets and submit the information to the IHSA.
 - b. IHSA Regional/Sectional Pairings: The pairings are posted on-line.
 - c. Division III IADA Meeting: Hinsdale South High School, October 30, 2008 at 1:00pm.

- d. Rules Interpretation Meetings: Wrestling and Basketball will be available on-line for the winter season.
- VII. Athletic Schedule Committee: Mr. Ted Robbins, Mr. Rich Piatckek, Mr. Bob Fabrizio, and Mr. Joe Skowronski distributed the proposal for review. Mr. Chris Olson motioned to approve the proposal and present the document to the principals at the next scheduled meeting. Mr. Randy Konstans seconded. Motion passed 12-0.
- a. Mr. Mark Sutton reminded the athletic directors that enrollment re-alignment was previously approved by the principals. Evaluation of enrollment figures will take place every two years based on September 30th enrollment. Mr. Rich Piatckek clarified that enrollment on September 30, 2010 will determine re-alignment for the following two years.
 - b. Mr. Ted Robbins and Mr. Rich Piatckek will present the proposal on Thursday, September 18, 2008.
- VIII. Individual Sports Reports
- a. Volleyball – Conference matches are underway; please remind your coaching staff of the importance for reporting scores directly after a contest.
 - b. Football – Conference games are underway. Please remind your coaching staff to submit scores and to complete the score zone report at each home contest.
 - c. Soccer – No report.
 - d. Boys and Girls Golf –The Blue Division for Boy’s Golf; Cog Hill is the site for all levels. Mr. Randy Konstans is attempting to have the F/S Level play on #10. If this option is unavailable the Blue Division at the lower level may have to move the site to Inwood Golf Course.
 - e. Girls Tennis – Reconfirmed that the conference meet is Friday and Saturday only.
 - f. Boys and Girls Cross Country – The Pre-Season Conference Meet went extremely well. The event had over 700 entries. A recommendation for a guideline revision (“Rain Date”) will be discussed in the Post-Season Meeting.
 - g. Swimming and Diving – No report.

 - d. Mr. T.J. Shirley reported that the athletic directors from School District 205 met with Superintendent Kamala Buckner to address the requirements of the settlement agreement. School District 205 confirmed that each school will offer all levels of the required athletic programs. In addition, each school will offer a Cross Country Team eliminating the co-op program.
