

# **SOUTHWEST SUBURBAN CONFERENCE: Boys' Swimming: Sport Guidelines**

## **I. Season Limitations**

- A. Practice may begin on Monday, November 23, 2009.
- B. First contest may be held on Friday, December 4, 2009.
- C. Season ends on Saturday, February 27, 2010.

## **II. Contest Limitations (Exclusive of the IHSA State Series)**

- A. Team – fourteen (14) dates.
- B. Individual – seventeen (17) meets

## **III. Levels of Competition**

- A. Varsity
- B. Junior Varsity

## **IV. Coaches Meeting**

- A. Pre-season meeting will be hosted by Lincoln-Way East High School at 6:00 p.m. on October 28 at Bolingbrook as a part of the SWSC winter mega-meeting.
- B. Post-season meeting will be held on Wednesday, February 10, 2010, at Lincoln-Way East at 7:00 p.m. at a site to be determined.

## **V. Championships and Awards**

- A. Team Awards
  1. A championship trophy shall be awarded to the winner of the conference division meet at the varsity level.
  2. An engraved plate will be awarded to the winner of the conference division meet at the JV level.
  3. In case of a tie for the championship, duplicate trophies/plates will be awarded.
- B. Individual Awards
  1. Varsity top six (6) individual finishers will receive medals on neck drapes. For each event in conference division meets, the top two (2) individuals will be declared All-Conference. (If the divisions are combined into one meet, these numbers are doubled).
  2. Awards will be given to the top six (6) individual finishers at the JV level.
  3. Individuals not on a school team may receive individual awards but will not score any team points.
- C. Relay Event Awards
  1. Varsity top three (3) relay team finishers will receive medals on neck drapes. For each event in conference division meets, the 1<sup>st</sup> place relay team and will be declared All-Conference.
  2. Awards will be given to the top three (3) relay team finishers at the JV level.

## **VI. Terms of Contests**

- A. Dual Meets
  1. The visiting team at all contests will swim in the odd lanes.
  2. Event numbering for line-up entries will be as follows:

3. The host school is responsible for providing locker room facilities, officials, timers and scorers.
  4. Visiting schools are responsible to provide their own locks and towels (visiting schools are responsible for supervising their assigned locker rooms).
  5. If there is no diving, a fifteen (15) minute break must be substituted.
  6. Three (3) boys per event for each school, unless the pool has less than six (6) lanes. Exhibition swimmers will participate by mutual agreement of both competing schools' head swimming coaches.
  7. Teams arriving late for dual meets will be allowed a minimum fifteen (15) minute warm-up period from the time the team and coach arrive on deck.
  8. National Federation Rules will be followed for the conduct of the meet.

### **B. Division Championship Meet**

1. The Conference Championship Meet will consist of the Varsity and JV levels.
2. Individual events -- Two (2) swimmers/divers per school
3. Relay events -- One (1) team per school.
4. Swimmers will be seeded in heats for each event following National Federation seeding.
5. All swimming events will be timed finals (as in Sectionals).
6. The winner of each event will be the Division Champion.
7. Points will be awarded to the first ten (10) places.
8. The format for the Division Meet will be:
  - a. Diving -- Saturday morning starting at 9:00 A.M.

- b. Swimming -- Saturday starting at 1:00 P.M. On ACT/SAT test dates, swimming will start at 2:00 P.M. and diving the night before.
  9. The diving panel for the Division Championship Meet will be determined at the seed meeting.
  10. The diving panel will consist of two (2) IHSA officials, three (3) coaches drawn at random from the pool of coaches and one (1) IHSA meet referee.
  11. The Division Championship Meet will use all lanes for the competition.
  12. All IHSA guidelines should be followed for things not covered in the SWSC guidelines.
- C. Organization for Division Championship Meet
1. There will be a seeding meeting two or three days prior to the championship meet. Host schools may request entries prior to the seeding meeting. The divers may practice at the host school during the seeding meeting (from 7:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.). Each school shall furnish a supervisor for their divers.
  2. At the seeding meeting, a panel of diving judges will be selected by vote of the Head Coaches if more than five (5) apply. (This will provide five (5) diving judges; one high and one low score will be eliminated and the dives will be judged on the three middle scores). In the event that this differs from the IHSA, the IHSA system will be followed.
  3. Officials hired for conference meet include three (3) for Friday and Saturday diving and swim finals.
    - a. Diving officials -- one (1) official will act as diving referee and two (2) will act as diving judges.
    - b. Swim officials -- Three (3) officials will be present to act as starter, referee, stroke, turn and relay take-off judge and finish judge.
  4. A "Games Committee" will be made up of the meet manager, the three officials, and three appointed coaches.
  5. The host school will be responsible for furnishing timers for each lane, plus two alternate timers. When requested by the host school, timers from other schools may be called upon to time.
  6. For teams who arrive late, a minimum of twenty (20) minutes will be allowed.
  7. Division Championship Seed Meeting
    - a. The seeding meeting will begin at 7:00 p.m.
    - b. Agenda includes:
      - i. Business meeting (old and new business)
      - ii. Submit JV entries.
      - iii. Seed JV entries.
      - iv. Submit varsity entries.
      - v. Seed varsity entries.
      - vi. Set order of diving.
      - vii. Organize diving judges for JV/varsity meets.
      - viii. Assign locker rooms, if possible.
      - ix. Choose division conference meet committee.
    - c. The host school will provide a time schedule.
    - d. All participating schools should have a representative at the seeding meeting.

- 100 Yard Backstroke
- 100 Yard Breaststroke
- 400 Yard Freestyle Relay

## **VII. Officials**

- A. Two (2) officials for a dual meet.
- B. *Three (3)* officials for the Division Championship Meet for the diving and swim portions.

## **VIII. Reporting Results**

- A. Each varsity and sophomore coach (or their designee) will record their conference home game scores on the SWSC conference website at [www.athletics2000.com/swsc](http://www.athletics2000.com/swsc).
- B. The Resource Athletic Director shall oversee the results of all league contests and compile the official standing for league records on the conference web site.
- C. Each host school will report conference division championship meet results to the resource A.D. and the Historian.
- D. Each host school is responsible to report results of the division championship meet immediately after the event to all local newspapers.
